Mission and Goal Statement

Mission:

The Executive Committee consists of a minimum of six trustees, four of which are the elected officers of the MRRRA: Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer and Secretary together, one who is the immediate past Chair, and one designated by the Board. (In the event that the immediate past Chair is no longer a trustee, one of the remaining trustees will be designated by the Board to serve on the Executive Committee.) The primary function of this committee is to meet and consult with the Executive Director between regular Board meetings in order to provide policy guidance as to the conduct of the day-to-day business of the MRRRA.

Goals:

- Monitor the work of the MRRRA committees to assure that work is consistent with committee and MMRA goals and work plan.
- Monitor the work and performance of the MRRRA Executive Director to assure that the Director is leading the staff in a way to accomplish the objectives of their respective positions and collectively for the organization.
- In concert with the Executive Director monitor the work of the consultants to MRRRA to assure that the work is of high quality and presented on a timely basis.
- Assist the Executive Director in setting agenda items for future meetings of the Authority.
- Provide regular reports on the progress of the MRRRA in accomplishing its mission to implement the Master Reuse Plans for BNAS and the Topsham Annex.
- Work cooperatively with MRRRA's host communities, other communities and counties in the Midcoast region, and the State of Maine, including maintaining contact and facilitating communication between the host communities and MRRRA, especially among elected officials and concerned citizens.
