Subject: NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT PLAN

MRRRA's Natural Resource Management Plan sets a high standard for resource protection that requires a strong commitment to natural resource management by responsible entities" (NRMP, p.1). Resource preservation as well smart growth principles documented in MRRRA's Reuse Master Plan and Community Design Guidelines are recognized in the NRMP. Research and inventory in the NRMP are based off of the Navy's Integrated Natural Resource Management Plan and are updated with findings from the Environmental Impact Statement and the Reuse Master Plan for our purposed for current and anticipated land holdings. Though the NRMP is written specifically for the MRRRA controlled properties, there is an overarching theme over collaboration and communication with adjacent property owners and key stakeholders. In its development, MRRRA consulted with the Town of Brunswick, Maine IF&W, and Bowdoin College. The NRMP includes the Wildlife Hazard Management Plan for the Brunswick Executive Airport.

Recommendation – Approval of MRRRA Natural Resources Management Plan.
